The New Mexico Department of Game and Fish (Department) has reviewed the above referenced mine permit renewals. Westmoreland San Juan Mining, LLC and Chevron Mining, Inc. (permittees) have submitted mine permit renewal applications for the La Plata and McKinley Coal Mines. Both mines are currently in the reclamation phase, with MMD waiting to assess post-reclamation 10-year vegetation growth. Other than minor repair work, the permittees are not proposing any changes to the permit boundaries or operation and reclamation plans.

The Department does not anticipate any significant impacts to wildlife or wildlife habitat resulting from the proposed permit renewals. Because post-mining land use is designated as wildlife habitat, the Department requests to be notified and included in future mine site inspections that assess the status and condition of post-reclamation revegetation at any coal mines in New Mexico. As appropriate, the Department would also like to work with the Coal Program to provide recommendations to further enhance wildlife habitat at coal mine reclamation sites.
